































# Bond Assessment Book Chart

<b>Starter Papers (6 – 7 Years)</b>					Preparation for entrance exams at age 7, or transferring from KS1 to KS2 including KS1 National Tests
<b>First Papers (7 – 8 Years)</b>					Introducing children to more formal assessment, including optional tests at Y3
<b>Second Papers (8 – 9 Years)</b>					Developing more complex skills in a formal context, including optional tests at Y4
<b>Third Papers (9 – 10 Years)</b>					Building skills towards the 11+ year, or optional tests at Y5
