

7 - 8 Writing Ideas

Paper 1	<p>Imagine Thumbelina lived on a beach. Write some words and phrases about where she lived. When you have collected these words and phrases about Thumbelina's home on the beach put them into three or four sentences describing the setting in which she lived.</p>
Paper 3	<p>Imagine you are Zoe. Write a letter to Charlotte, telling her you would love to see her new baby sister on Sunday 30th October. You will need to make up an imaginary address for Zoe!</p>
Paper 4	<p>Write the heading <u>What to do when you cut yourself</u> . Write the passage as a list of points. <i>e.g. 1. Wash the cut with water.</i></p>
Paper 8	<p>Draw a picture of the March Hare, Alice, the Hatter and the Dormouse. Then, using the first five lines of the story on page 17, write in speech bubbles what each character said.</p>
Paper 9	<p>Do you like the poem 'Chips'? Write three reasons why you like or dislike this poem.</p>
Paper 11	<p>Imagine you need the information about 'Touch' for a school project but you are unable to take the book out of the library. Write notes under each heading (<u>Touching</u>, <u>Keeping Us Safe</u>, <u>Blind people</u>) to remind you what it said.</p>
Paper 15	<p>Write some sentences about the bear to describe what he looked like. Include descriptive phrases about his teeth, fur, eyes, claws and size.</p>
Paper 17	<p>Continue the story, describing what Chin does next to find the dragon that lives on the mountain. Try to make the story interesting by adding something unexpected.</p>
Paper 18	<p>Imagine you are the owner of Mac the dog. If someone phones you thinking they might have seen Mac you want to be prepared. Write four questions that you would ask that might help you find Mac.</p>
Paper 20	<p>Imagine you are Chris and are getting ready for your party. Your Mum has asked you to write a list of things needed to play 'Musical Statues', 'Pass the Parcel' and 'Pin the Tail on the Donkey'. Write the name of each game and under each heading write a list of what is needed to play it.</p>
